B. Competition Disciplins:

1. KATA – individual

Groups	allowed Kata	Modus
Group A	Taikyoku Shodan, Heian 1-2	Kata may be repeated
Group B	Taikyoku Shodan, Heian 1-5, Heian Oi Komi, Bassai-Dai, Kanku-Dai, Jion, Enpi, Taiji Shodan	Different kata in the final than in the semi-finals
Group C	free Kata	Different kata in the final than in the semi-finals

2. KATA – Team (Mix Teams allowed)

The table applies as for Kata Individual

Group C: Ages 14 and over must demonstrate Kata Bunkai in the final.

A team must have at least 2 participants from the same group. A starter may be one graduation level and/or age level higher or lower. The organizer reserves the right to combine categories. **Each athlete is only allowed to start in one kata team!**

4. FUKUGO

In groups C5 – C10 you can start in the FUKUGO discipline. Here you alternately run the Kata Kitei or start in Kogo Kumite (C5 & C6) or Jiyu Kumite (C7 - C10). The final is always the Kogo or Jiyu Kumite.

5. ENBU

All karateka can start in this discipline, whereby each starter can be represented in a maximum of two teams (one m/f and one m/m or f/f).

Enbu teams are possible in M/M, F/F and M/F. m=male, w=female

6. KUMITE

The attack in KIHON-IPPON and JIYU-IPPON Kumite takes place without acknowledging the announced attack technique. The attack must be carried out within 5 seconds of announcing the attack technique.

6.3 Group C5 & C6

Kogo Kumite Individual & Team

Teeth, groin and chest protection are mandatory (WFF gloves can be worn)

6.4 Group C7 – C10

JIYU-Kumite Individual & Team

Teeth, groin and chest protection are mandatory (WFF gloves can be worn)

The following applies to Kumite teams:

The order of fighters on a team will be presented in writing to the table staff by the coach or team captain before the pool begins. A Kumite team consists of 3 participants. A starter may be one age group higher or lower.

The rules of the World Fudokan Federation WFF apply.
